1. PRINCIPES ET VALUES

This competition is for athletes with functional limitations who do not have the opportunity to participate in a regular environment and/or with the RSEQ (non-inclusive).

Participation in Défi sportif AlterGo must be done in healthy and friendly competition environment. Although these sporting events encourage young participants to challenge themselves and to improve their performance, the emphasis is on the importance of participating in these competitive activities.

Key Word: Respect

Participants must be respectful of others as well as their individual differences.

We must not forget that these young athletes are in the process of learning instructions and rules.

Défi sportif AlterGo is an event that gives young athletes the opportunity to participate in a competitive activity in a friendly environment and live unforgettable experiences.

All the members of a team must play equally.

2.2. Registration platform

For registrations, connect to the registration platform. Each school is responsible for its registrations.

2.3. Registration limit

Each schools and rehab centers, can register a limited number of young athletes. Refer to the table below for details.

Each athlete will be able take part in a maximum of **4 individual or team events**.
Exception : mini-marathon is not included in these events.

If an event only has one registration, the event will be cancelled. The athlete will be given the option to register in a different event.

All team sports are divided by school level (elementary and high school).

Divisions are determined by registrations, the number of teams and the previous year's results. If a team has won the gold medal the year before, they have to register in a higher level. Defi sportif AlterGo can decide if there can be an exception.

At the high school level, a minimum of 3 teams per division is required; Défi sportif AlterGo's organizers could decide to modify the teams.

2.4. Registration costs

Examples:

3. ADMISSION CRITERIA

The athletes are divided by school levels: elementary or high school.

- Elementary: 5 to 12 years old (A 13 year-old participant still attending an elementary school may obtain a waiver and compete with his classmates)

- High school: 13 to 21 years old

Age will be determined as of January 1st of the current school year.

4. DIVISIONS

The Défi sportif AlterGo team as well as the sports consultant will be responsible for establishing team divisions.

Schools can be evaluated by the competitions coordinator and/or a representative of Défi sportif AlterGo.

A grading scale is available for each section of a team sport in this document.

An error in classification will automatically disqualify the team.

A school can enroll only one team per sport. However, a school with elementary and high school athletes can register one team per level.

If a school is able to enroll more than one team in an event, the second team will be placed on a waiting list. If, according to registration, there is still space available to add teams, there will be a random draw.

5. PREREQUISITE

5.1. For the athletes representative

5.1.1. Webinaire

A representative from each school must watch the webinar for school sports.

5.1.2. Sport relevant and rules

The representative commits to sharing all the relevant information and rules with adults accompanying the students of their school.

5.2. For the young athletes

Athletes competing in a regular league or in the regular RSEQ cannot take part in any of the team sports events at Défi sportif AlterGo.

6.1. Results and Medals Ceremony

Official results are final and will be available on [Le Defi Sportif Altergo website](#) (24 hours after the competition).

The type of tournament for each team sport will be determined by enrolment. The finals will be organized as follow:

1st place against 2nd place = gold // silver

3rd place against 4th place = bronze // 4th place

In case the match for the bronze medal cannot occur for reasons beyond our control, the team in the 3rd position will receive the bronze medal. There will not have a bronze medal for a division with only 3 teams registered.

6.2. Delay

6.2.1. Individual events

In individual sports, **the athlete is disqualified if he or she is not on time for the event.**

6.2.2. Team events

For team events, a team is allowed a 5 minutes delay at the first match of the tournament. In the event of a late start, the team will play the remaining time in the match.

Match schedules must be respected at all times. Every match will start on time. A beep will indicate the start of each game. A team that is absent at the time of the beep will be considered defeated. The opposite team will be the winner and will receive the points established for each sport.

6.3. Dress code

Sportswear is mandatory for each participant and highly recommended for the accompanist. **Jeans will not be tolerated for athlete and their guide on the competing surface.**

For team sports, **we encourage each team to wear a uniform** (ex. shorts and t-shirt). Each ball hockey, baseball, basketball, and soccer team must wear matching numbered jerseys.

6.4. Companions

Minimum companion ratio for the event:

- Intellectual disability: 1 for 8 athletes
- Physical disability: 1 for 5 athletes

Please plan to have female and male companions for the changing rooms.

6.5. Cases of disqualifications

6.5.1. Non-compliance with admission criteria

6.5.2. Unfairness of players

All the members of a team must play equally. All the athletes must have been on the bench at least one time during a game. Volunteers will keep track of the players on the bench.

The sports consultant will be allowed to disqualify a team that does not respect this rule. After one warning, the team will lose the current game.
